THINGS TO BRING

- Bible, **Quiet Time Diary** (WOL Quiet Time Diaries available @ snack shack for \$25), Pencils, notebook
- Toiletry articles: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, comb, deodorant, lotion, washcloth and 2 towels (1 for swimming, 1 for showers) Sun block if needed.
- Linens: two sheets and a blanket, or a sleeping bag, and a pillow.
- Extra pair of sneakers or swim shoes to wear while swimming and traveling to and from swimming.
- Money for snack shop –Money will be placed in camp bank for security. Campers will be able to withdraw from their account as necessary. Any remaining funds after camp will be returned to each camper.
- Bug repellent, water bottle and flashlight.

- ANY NECESSARY MEDICATION - All prescription drugs must be put in a zip lock bag clearly marked with dosage and campers name. Upon arrival medication must be given to the camp nurse for safekeeping.

- Pack a light windbreaker to keep warm during our nighttime activities.

DRESS CODE

Girls: No spaghetti strap shirts. Shirts must have at least a 2" strap. Only ONE piece bathing suits and must wear gym type shorts over swim suit.

Boys: Shirt must be worn at all times. No speedos allowed, only "shorts" style swim trunks.

All: Shorts must not be shorter than the length of finger tips when hands are held at side of the body.



Footwear must be worn at all times: Sneakers for all game times and swim shoes or an old pair of sneakers for swimming.

As it is winter we would like to remind you that leggings are not to be worn as pants. If you choose to wear leggings they must be worn with appropriate fingertip length shorts or pants.
